**TENNESSEE DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE
VEHICLE SERVICES**

Governor Haslam recently signed the IMPROVE ACT into law. The plan provides a net tax cut for Tennesseans resulting in a tax savings for an average Tennessee family, cutting nearly \$500 million at full implementation and delivering nearly 1,000 road and bridge projects across the State of Tennessee.

In order to fund the improvements, the plan calls for an **INCREASE IN VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES AND GAS/DIESEL TAXES** as well as an **ADDITIONAL FEE OF \$100 FOR ELECTRIC VEHICLE REGISTRATION.** The increases in the registration fees go 100% to the highway fund.
